FAILURE OF A 345,000 VOLT SF₆ INSULATED SUBSTATION BUS & 700 MVA TRANSFORMER

Brosz and Associates is pleased to announce the favorable subrogation settlement in a matter involving the failures of a utility's 345,000 volt SF₆ (sulphur hexafluoride) insulated substation bus, and associated 700 MVA generator step up transformer.

The entrapment of water into the aluminum bus conductor during a repair operation, as well as welding pinholes on the six (6) inch aluminum tubular conductor assembly were the major factors contributing to the failure. Upon energization, water and water vapour in the conductor warmed up, and migrated through the pinholes in the factory aluminum weld into the SF_6 gas space. A dielectric breakdown then resulted
